BEL-RAY CONGRATULATES TEAM USA AND BEL-RAYDER MANDI MASTIN ON ISDE WIN!

September 2008—Congratulations are in order for all the racers, volunteers, sponsors and staff who were part of the Team USA effort at the International Six Days Enduro (ISDE) in Serres, Greece! The U.S. Trophy Team finished on the podium, the team's best result at the ISDE since the Trophy Team finished second in 1982, while the U.S. Women's Trophy Team finished second in the women's division, including Bel-Ray sponsored Amanda Mastin, and the Junior Trophy Team scored a hard-fought 12th.

In all, Team USA scored 10 gold, 15 silver and 2 bronze medals. There were two DNFs. This is one of the U.S. team's strongest performances at the "Olympics of Motorcycling."

The ISDE is one of the longest-running competitive events in motorcycling and is also considered one of the most difficult. Over the six days and upwards of 1250 miles, a rider must contend with strict rules about time allowances and restrictions on mechanical replacements, carrying out his or her own track-side repairs. The ISDE is a true test of a rider and machine ability.
